### **Logging into your Student Email:**

- 1. Go to www.gmail.com
- 2. Type in your student email. Your email is the first letter of your first name, your full last name, the last two digits of your student ID, and @ sccs-stu.net
  - a. Example: iruiz12@sccs-stu.net
    - i. First letter of your first name
    - ii. Your full last name (If you have a hyphenated last name, do not include the hyphen. If you have more than one name, your email might be one or both of your last names)
    - iii. Last two digits of your student ID number
    - iv. @sccs-stu.net
- 3. Type in your initial password
  - a. All passwords will be: stu#### Ex: stu12345
    - i. The #### represent your 5 digit student ID number
- 4. After you enter your password, click accept
- 5. Create a new password



# **How is High School Attendance Different?**

- In High School <u>ATTENDANCE IS BY PERIOD</u>
- Parents may excuse an illness 14 times
- •However... 3 consecutive days must be verified with a doctor's note
- •Tardies are not excused, unless verified by a doctor's note
- •3 unexcused period absences = Saturday School
- •12 unexcused period tardies = Saturday School



# Positive Behavior Expectations

Soquel High School practices positive discipline - we recognize that students may make bad choices, but they are not bad people. For minor discipline issues we follow a district-wide behavior/consequence matrix that reflects a progression in consequences. Administrative action may include:

- letter of apology
- educational assignments
- community service
- conflict resolution
- loss of privileges (participation in extracurricular activities, attendance at school events)

In order for ALL students to feel welcome, supported, and safe, some behaviors will not be tolerated. Suspensions and expulsions are reserved for the following offenses.

- Hate, harassment, and bullying
- Violence and threats of violence to students and/or school personnel
- Possession/use of weapons
- Possession/use of drugs and alcohol


